

June 2019 Voters Meeting

Opening Prayer by Pastor Awe.

Terry Koebernick made a motion to approve the May Minutes. 2nd by Richard Quandt. Passed.

Robert Billiar made a motion to approve the May Treasurer's Report. 2nd by Terry Koebernick. Passed.

Richard Quandt made a motion to approve the May Financial Secretary's Report. 2nd by Terry Koebernick. Passed.

Laverne Koebernick made a motion to approve the May Individual Financial Reports. 2nd by Richard Quandt. Passed.

Education: Board of Ed met on June 5th. We discussed hosting a Sunday School teacher and VBS volunteer dinner - it will take place after Bible class on June 23rd. VBS went well. We served about 75 children total. The money raised during VBS week went towards the Hispanic ministry of Siouxland. There will be a scavenger hunt event hosted by the Siouxland Youth Committee at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Sioux City on Saturday, June 22 from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Finally, a couple has been approached to give prayerful consideration to being youth leaders for the church.

Trustees: The door knob on the Ed. Building has been replaced. The blocks around the sign have been secured. Dirt was added, and topped off with river rock. Shrubs will be added at a later date. The rain gutters have been installed on the Ed building. Just getting bids on replacing more gutter on the church and adding the gutter helmet.

Elders: The Elders welcomed Bob Billiar to the Board. Angle will be on vacation July 15 - 19. We will seek volunteers to fill in. Pastor Awe will be on his trip to the Congo July 5-15. He will also lead the mission team to Poland, returning on July 29. Pastor Witte is covering on the 7^{th} and 14^{th} and possibly the remaining Sundays. Ordination/Installation of Paul Flo will be June 30 at 4 PM. The Hispanic Ministry Committee will organize a dinner following the service.

Stewardship: Board reviewed the May 2019 Financial Secretary report, bank statement and budget reports, and all looked good. Pat Glover walked the Board through the monthly transfers to/from savings and how the various savings accounts are accessed. Board was very impressed with the detailed notes and support Pat maintains. Big job – she is very organized! Board reviewed the Memorial committee activity and all looked good. Board reviewed the revised "Time & Talent" survey and recommends we distribute it in September during a church service and encourage members to return that day or the following Sunday. We will also work with Angie to distribute surveys to members absent that Sunday. Our next regular meeting will be Thursday July 11 @ 4pm.

Memorial Committee: The Committee will have memorial money available to reimburse VBS for 2019 expenses. Checks to reimburse Pastor Awe for the Africa Medical Mission and Poland Mission were written. \$4320.50 for Africa plus \$1300.00 and \$3576.27 (total \$4876.07) for the Poland trip. The committee will give the Voters a presentation of the Memorials spreadsheet at their meeting in August. A request for a brass altar cross was declined for lack of a motion.

Missions: No report.

Hispanic Mission Committee: The information packet containing information about Sioux City, South Sioux City and the Siouxland area has been sent to Paul Flo. He has replied back. Invitations to the ordination/installation will be sent to Siouxland area churches. Discussed menu options for the dinner that follows the ordination/installation on June 30th. No new updates from the Treasurer. "Seasons of Change" workshop in Seward was attended by Kevin Diediker,

Sheila Floyd, Darwyn and Pat Glover, Pastor Witte, and Dave Schable. The workshop had information about how a congregation can welcome a new Pastor. Pastor Witte gave a report on the event. Next HMC group meeting on May 28, 6:00 pm. HMC will meet again on June 13 at 6:30 p.m. Pastor Witte updated us about the invitation to Carlos Hernandez from California to be a guest speaker here. Rolando Luna gave the committee an overview of cultural differences that challenge our Hispanic Ministry and how his experiences can help the ministry move forward. Further discussion was made on the meal plans for the ordination/installation dinner on June 30th. Pastor Witte will be in Germany for the next 2 weeks, returning on June 13. Next Siouxland HMC Group meeting will be June 18, 6:00 p.m. Thank-you letters are being sent out to donors.

Paul Flo should be arriving in South Sioux City on June 24, possibly the 25th. His father will arrive on the 25th with a U-Haul that will need unloading. Sharon and Clarrene will organize a "Pantry Shower" for Paul Flo. HMC will meet again on July 11 at 6:00.

Friendship Committee: The Chamber Coffee Hour held at Hope on May 24th went great. There was a good attendance. About 60 people. We served rolls, smoothies and coffee. Some of the business people bid on the "Silent Auction" items. We bought T-shirts for VBS. Averaged about 45 kids each day. We gave 25 small T-shirts to Cubby Care Daycare Center for their 3-and 4-year old's. Also gave them music and crafts. We will help with the installation dinner.

President's Report: Thank you for coming.

Pastor's Report: Pastor Awe will be using his vacation time to go on the Congo Medical Mission trip and then going to Poland for that mission trip. He will be going to Poland in the place of Suzy, who has hurt her back, and can't take the long plane trip. Pastor is also asking for help to do a repair on a closet door at his house. Pastor Awe was appointed as 4th Vice President of the Nebraska District.

Old Business: We are still looking at July to install the cold air returns in the rooms and east hall wing. July 6th and the 13th are set aside to do the tile in the Ed. Building. Gary Massey has stayed in contact to help with the floor. It was noted that if you have any message that needs to go on the sign, an email needs to be sent to Bryce Andersen. He will be able to put it on the sign. Robert Billiar has made mention that he is the Lay Delegate that will be placing a vote for the President of Synod this Saturday. The vote will be done through the internet. Anyone wanting to see the Biographies of the candidates can talk with Robert.

New Business: The security-key and intercom system is a work in progress. Still getting bids. The doors are here and a bid from L&L Builders to install the special doors came in at about \$140.00 per door. The future plan is to get new doors installed throughout the church and all the doors will be keyed the same. The keys will be given out and you will have to sign for it. If the key is lost, it will be your responsibility to have all the locks changed. Currently the church records and streams (broadcasts) Sunday services from a donated computer with some other technology that could use an update. Different pieces of the sound system (specifically organ speakers) have been periodically not working. The decision to update the sound system began when an amount of \$15,000+ was donated to the church with a designation to be used for technology. Bryce Andersen determined the quote given by BNY Productions to be insufficient for our needs. Instead, he has found a supplier for the equipment needed to update the sound system, and will donate his time for installation. This quote includes a new router to increase internet speed and allow for easier streaming of services, new cameras that will improve the quality of the recordings, a computer that is designed to control recording church services, a television for the nursery so that parents who need to leave the sanctuary can still participate in services, new wireless microphones, a mixing board that will replace both mixing boards we have now (one is broken), and all of the cords/cables needed to connect these things. The total cost for

those items is approximately \$10,000. Televisions to replace the large projector screen in the middle of the church were proposed, but the voters decided not to proceed with those items at this time. It was also decided that the large projector screen can be moved from the sanctuary to the gym (to be used for Bible Class) as long as we do not find that it has a memorial designation to be used in the sanctuary. Katie presented this quote and encouraged anyone with questions or ideas for the use of the remaining \$5,000 to speak to her or Bryce. The election of officers was up next. Everyone was given a ballot to look over the candidates. Any blanks on the ballots would allow for write-ins to that specific board. If you are going to nominate someone to a board, you must have their permission to submit their name. President Glover had to ask 3 times if there were any nominations from the floor for these boards. Ed Stone made a motion to accept this slate by acclimation. 2nd by Terry Koebernick. Passed. June 30th is the installation of all Board members during the regular worship service.
