Terry Koebernick made a motion to approve the March Minutes. 2nd by Ed Stone. Passed. Terry Koebernick made a motion to approve the March Treasurer's Report. 2nd by Dave Calvert. Passed. Pat Glover made a motion to approve the March Financial Secretary's Report. 2nd by Laverne Koebernick. Passed. Laverne Koebernick made a motion to approve the March Individual Summary of Accounts. 2nd by Terry Koebernick. Passed.

Christian Education: No Report.

Trustees: The screen in the gym has been lowered. Waiting for the parts on the projector system, so it can be installed. Spring cleanup around the church has been done.

Elders: Meeting was held on Tuesday, March 31st 2020 due to Corona Virus concerns. Communion assistant assignment is on hold until the 10 – person per gathering restriction is lifted at the end of April. Worship services limited to 10 people can be held in the Sanctuary, gym and the two halves of the Education Building concurrently. That would allow as many as 40 worshippers at our facility. Pastor Awe is working on 3 adult confirmations and a baptism on Palm Sunday. Communion will be given at this service. Pastors Awe, Witte and Flo will administer Holy Communion on Maundy Thursday and Easter Sunday. Weather permitting, we will hold an outdoor Easter Sunrise Service (no Communion) at 7:00 A.M. and Worship services at 9:15 and 10:30 with Holy Communion. Maundy Thursday and Good Friday services will be at the usual 7:00 P.M. time. The Poland trip on July 28 is still on. Pastor Awe's trips to Sierra Leone and Germany have been cancelled. Our outdoor sign and website will be updated to reflect up-to-date information. The Elders want to thank everyone for all their cooperation and to the Alter Guild for all the extra work put in over this Easter Season.

Stewardship: Board reviewed both the February and March 2020 bank statements, budget reports, bank account transfers, Memorial and Church savings account activity and all looked good. Board discussed the recommendation to cover the temporary budget shortage with savings and recommend we use our savings as opposed to seeking government assistance which may be needed elsewhere. Board is following up on missing talent surveys for the Church database, and decided to hold off requests until attendance restrictions are lifted to make completion easier. Our next meeting is set for **Thursday, May 14 @ 4pm.**

Memorial Committee: The committee discussed moving the funds designated as scholarships to the Scholarship Committee. Marie will follow up. Altar flowers for the Fowlers are being taken care this week by Marie and Ed. Pastor Awe noted that the funds from Don Esch, though unrestricted, should be used with the understanding that both Don and the family had expressed interest in missions, education, and Hispanic Ministry. The committee reviewed the tracking spreadsheet.

Missions: We will not have a Mission Board meeting on Tuesday, 21, 2020.

We will not have the Rib Fest/Silent Auction on April 26. We hope to still have this event but we will wait until groups may once again gather...and plan accordingly later this summer or fall. At this time the Poland trip is still scheduled for July. For now, we will have our meetings by e-mails and letters, calls, texts. If you send questions, comments, ideas to me I will compile them and send them on to everyone so we can read, ponder and discuss the items. As for now think about: Gift baskets and items that will be good to sell on the silent auction. Service projects we can do to help share God's love while safe distancing. Continue to pray for your missionary as they may be back in the states concerned for their people in the field or they may still be in the field concerned for their family in the states; either way a sticky situation. Pray for Pastor Flo and his family. Pray for our nation and world as everyone is affected by this pandemic.

Janet Tripp from Holy Cross in the Dunes says her church wants to support our ministry. We need to come up ways they can help. Next Siouxland HM group meeting July 16, 6:00 p.m. HMC will meet again on August 8 at 6:00.

Pastor's Report: Thank you for giving him the time off to be with his father during his illness. The people that Pastor Flo has been in contact with has told him not to worry about the newsletter, but to concentrate on things at hand. They said to work on the newsletter for next month. Thank you to the Board of Ed for the books for the confirmation youth.

Friendship Committee: No Report.

President's Report: Thank you coming. It's nice to see a good turnout, due to the situation.

Pastor's Report: He is staying on top of the situation according to what the government and the CDC are saying. There are 2 restrictions for churches. One is for April 30th and the other is May 11th. Pastor Awe will be staying in touch with the Elders to take a look at the transitions and different reports to see if they loosen the guidelines. Please stay connected to the web site for church details. If anyone should have questions about the situations at the church can feel free to call, email or text Pastor Awe. Sierra Leone and the Germany trip have been cancelled. The Poland trip is still on. The Africa Mission trip to Ghana in September is still on. Everything will still depend on all the government regulations. Pastor has gotten emails and other reports about the online church services. This is a good report. Pastor did an Official act on April 17th. He did a funeral prayer service at the mortuary in Lee, Nebraska for Betty Jean Dolezal. She was a member at Zion Lutheran Church in Lee, Nebraska. For VBS, we are still planning to do something. We are just waiting to see what develops. This is planned for June 15th.

Old Business: There was a question on the Facility Usage Agreement. If nonmembers wish to use the gym to play basketball, there would be a charge of \$100.00. Members will get to use the gym free of charge. We will have to make the Secretary aware of how the agreement works. A motion by Richard Quandt and 2nd by Dave Calvert to exempt the group "Mid-Step Services" to use the gym. Passed. The security-key and intercom system will be addressed at the next meeting. The bids are in and roughly \$8,000 can get the system up and running. If the voter would like more things added, then the cost goes up. Right now, we can still make adjustments to the system with the cost going accordingly. The voters are to think about this and come back with their thoughts. The money is there to do the project, and the safety of the Pastor and Secretary are at the front of this decision. There have been people that have needed to be in the church at different hours and their safety is of a concern also. A motion by Richard Quandt and 2nd by Ed Stone to let the Trustees and Darwyn Glover pursue the intercom system. Passed.

New Business: A motion made by Terry Koebernick and 2nd by Richard Quant to take the money collected from the Lenten suppers and apply it to the Poland trip. Passed. The Narthex walls are in need of repair. The walls will either be repapered or the existing paper will be removed so the walls can be textured and painted. Some of the materials are being donated. A committee with the Trustees was picked to decide on how to proceed with the walls. With COVID-19, the committee has not been able to meet, so this project will be on hold for the time being. The Chamber Coffee Hour has been cancelled until further notice. The carpet and the brick at the main entrance of the church is in need of repair. This will be taken care of by Darwyn and Crew. The voters tabled the issue about adding TV's in the church. Now would be a good time to think about what should be done and bring thoughts and ideas back to the Voters Meeting again next month. The sound system to the nursery can be completed as soon as a part comes in. Treasurer Pat Glover reported that she transferred money from the LCEF account for operating expenses.
