Meeting called to order by President Glover.

Members Present: Pat Glover, Darwyn Glover, Terry Koebernick, Laverne Koebernick, Ed Stone, Sheila Floyd, Dave Calvert, Suzy Awe, Marie Wakefield, Sharon Weber with Pastor Witte, Pastor Flo, and Pastor Awe

Opening Prayer by Pastor Awe.

Pat Glover made a motion to approve the September Minutes. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Terry Koebernick. Passed. Laverne Koebernick made a motion to approve the September Treasurer's Report. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ed Stone. Passed. Laverne Koebernick made a motion to approve the September Individual Summary of Accounts. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Terry Koebernick. Passed. Pat Glover made a motion to approve the September Financial Secretary's Report. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Laverne Koebernick. Passed.

**Christian Education:** No Report.

Trustees: No Report.

Elders: Hope President, Glover, Chairman of the Nominating Committee presented to the Elders his plan to extend the terms of Officers and Boards to 2021. The Elders agree that with the ongoing Covid-19 situation all terms should be extended. This will be presented to the Voters assembly this month. Discussed Worship and Communion practices. We will keep current practices through November. Whether to have Advent suppers will be left up to the Voters. Pastor Awe encouraged Elders to keep making contact with members in their zones. How attendance at Worship is taken was discussed. Also, the count for communicants needs to be more accurate. Counting used communion cups might be useful. 2021 budget was set. It was reported that Rich Quandt is hospitalized with the Covid-19 virus, but is expecting to be released this coming Friday.

**Stewardship:** Board reviewed the September 2020 bank statements, budget reports, bank account transfers, Memorial and several Church savings accounts and clarified a couple items with Pat. All activity looked good. The Board also discussed Tom's plan to transfer to another church in Fremont, the need to add new members to the Stewardship Board and the option of combining some committees or Boards to make work more efficient. Our next meeting is set for Thursday, November 12 @ 4pm.

#### Memorial Committee: No Report.

**Missions:** Discussed ways of getting members to come back to church and how to make them feel safe in church. Discussed Other Mission Opportunities: A Silent Auction will take place during Advent. November 29<sup>th</sup>- December 20<sup>th</sup> with the proceeds going to the Poland Fund. We will put information in the Anchor, the bulletin and on the website. We are looking at a Christmas Family Dinner or a Christmas Family Brunch on December 20<sup>th</sup>. Will have Stuff the Stocking collection November 29th through December 20<sup>th</sup>. Discussed Other Mission Opportunities: Bake Sale/Brunch at Easter. Reviewed 2021 Proposed Budget. Next meeting – November 17, 2020 @ 6:00 p.m.

Hispanic Ministry Committee: We will not be receiving funds from LWML Nebraska South for 2021. Pastor Flo has already re-applied for the 2022 & 2023 grants. Pastor Flo gave an update on the Saturday Faith, Fun & Food program for confirmation. Pastor Boring suggested that we find a way to involve ESL students with the FFF program. Pastor Flo attended the Iowa District West meeting on the 6<sup>th</sup> and also met with Pastor Boring and Paul Petit in South Sioux City. The treasurer's report was reviewed. Mr. Petit will forward donor contact information to Sandy Calvert. Thoughts and ideas were shared as to how to maintain and grow our support group. Next Siouxland HM group meeting December 1<sup>st</sup>, 6:00 p.m. HMC will meet again on November 3<sup>rd</sup>, at 6:00 p.m.

**Pastor's Report:** Pastor Witte reported that he is still able to do the daily devotions on line. Sunday night worship usually has 5-8 people attending. Pastor Flo has been busy visiting other congregations. For the community, Pastor Flo has been asked to sit on the Board for Growing Community Connections, which consist of 4-6 people. This Board helps the Hispanics find resources in the community. The South Sioux City schools and Dakota City have asked Pastor Flo to help in areas of translating for them. This helps to be visible in the community. FFF has been

growing and this last week has been the largest yet with 15 in attendance. ESL is moving along.

Friendship Committee: No Report.

**President's Report:** Thank you for coming.

**Pastor's Report:** The Advent season is in progress on Pastor Awe's part. It will be finished by the next meeting. Still planning to have church moving as normal, until we hear otherwise from the government. That would mean normal Sunday and Wednesday services, 3 Advent services, Christmas Eve Candlelight and Christmas Day with Holy Communion services. With the lower attendance of Sunday School children, we are not sure of a Children's program. The rules for Hope Lutheran have not changed when it comes to suppers. The tables are 6 feet apart, only 8 people per table and 50% occupancy. On the church vacancy at Trinity, the people have met with Pastor Snow. They will be making a decision on how to proceed next.

**Old Business:** The Narthex wall repair is on hold until Darwyn gets a commitment from the company that carries the product that will be used on the walls. Right now, the product that was used 20 years ago is not available, but they have something that is close. When Darwyn gets a firm commitment on the lace pattern, we can proceed. If the work on the walls come too close to the holidays, the project will start after the first of the year. The renovation of the kitchen in the Ed Building came in with a bid of \$5400. Darwyn had talked with the fire marshal and he cleared the way for the renovation work. The extension of the counter top would not interfere with doorways. A motion to accept the bid from Nick Sebade for \$5400 to renovate the Ed building kitchen was made by Terry Koebernick. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Suzy Awe. Passed. The money for the renovation could come from the Thrivent funds, and Memorials. The soundproof interior wall in the Pastor's office will be on hold for a little longer. Waiting on a final cost. The carpet was installed at both doorways leading into the church. Curry Flooring installed the carpet. Darwyn and crew helped cut the cost by doing the prep work. The final cost for the project was \$1,311. This was paid for by the general fund.

New Business: A ballot with the names of people who are on the Church Boards for 2020, have agreed to stay on for another term. This will go for another 2 years, for the President and Treasurer. The others members will be on for 3 years. A motion by acclamation to accept the names on the ballot was made by Ed Stone and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Suzy Awe. Passed. Installation is set for the 8th of November. There are still a lot of positions open on the Boards. Pastor and the Chairman will be seeking more members. Members from other Boards will Not be asked to fill in on Boards that are missing members. If these Boards are not filled, the work cannot be done. There are job descriptions available for anyone wanting them. We need to appoint a Lay delegate to the NE District Convention. This will take place in Kearney, NE on June 18th and 19th, 2021. Dave Calvert made a motion and 2<sup>nd</sup> from Pat Glover to accept Ed Stone as our Lav delegate. Passed. One of the Pastors will also go. We need nominations for the District Board of Directors. Right now, Pastor Snow is the current District President. We can nominate any Pastor from the Nebraska District. Pastor Snow still has 2 terms left and is eligible for re-election. We need nominations for District President, Vice President, and there are 2 Lay positions open from our region. A motion by Ed Stone and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Terry Koebernick to accept the nominations of Pastor Richard Snow as President, Pastor Chris Asbury from Grace Lutheran, Norfolk as Vice President, and Virginia Von Seggern and Mick Onnen as the 2 Lay Delegates for the Board of Directors. Passed. All the Boards need to get their Budgets for the year, to the Chairman. The Budgets will be voted on in November. A letter from Congregations for Concordia University, Nebraska (CCUNE) was brought to our attention. This letter reminded us of the continuing financial remittances of its member congregations to help provide scholarships to eligible Concordia students. The amount of money from each congregation is 1% of the home budget. It was suggested that a call be put out to the listed name to discuss how to get caught up with our obligation. Pat will report back next month with what our obligations would be. The Trustees will be responsible for obtaining additional bids if any, for snow removal. It was never decided if Eric Heinemann will do the removal of snow in the parking lot, or if someone else was going to submit a bid. Darwyn will get in touch with the Trustees. The Men of Hope will be serving the first Advent supper on December 2<sup>nd</sup>, the Friendship Committee will serve on December 9th and Ladies Aid will serve on December 16.
